Rapid ReHousing

*Funded by a grant through the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD).

*Designed to assist individuals and families quickly exit homelessness and return to permanent housing.

*Focus on providing program participants with housing stabilization while linking participants to community resources through case management.

*Duration includes assistance for 6 months up to a year.

*Total gross rent cannot exceed fair market value.

*Rapid re-housing is an important component of a community's response to homelessness.

*A fundamental goal of rapid rehousing is to reduce the amount of time a person is homeless.

*Other eligibility requirements apply.



HOMELESS PREVENTION PROGRAM

*Designed to provide financial assistance in an effort to prevent families and individuals from eviction, losing their homes, or becoming homeless.

*Funded by a grant through the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD).

*Must have verification of at risk or imminent risk of homelessness.

*Duration includes assistance for 6 months up to a year.

*Assist in paying back rent when applicable.

*Other eligibility requirements do apply.

TENANT BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE

*Grant funded through the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD).

*Rental subsidy to assist individuals afford housing costs.

*Program goal for participants is self-sufficiency.

*Participants engage in case management to achieve program goals.

*Duration includes assistance up to a year.

*Total gross rent cannot exceed fair market value.

*Eligible applicants must be homeless or at risk of homelessness with income restrictions.

*Other eligibility requirements do apply.
